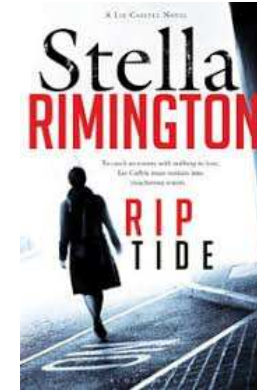


Heathfield Onliners
